- Joining a multidisciplinary project team in which you collaborate with logistic software partners, logistic providers and different business owners to ensure the smooth integration of logistic systems with other business processes;
- Develop and maintain process descriptions and functional specifications;
- Analysing and enriching logistics data;
- Develop IT logistics reporting and dashboarding;
- Coach the jr. logistic engineer colleague (1 FTE);
- Train new users on effective use of the systems.
